Sit-Tat	Myanmar Armed Forces or Tatmadaw (Myanmar Armed Forces exclusively uses its name as “Myanmar Tatmadaw,” which literally translates into “Myanmar Imperial or Royal Armed Forces” with the suffix “daw” or “taw” denoting “royal” or “sacred”. In fact, Myanmar People usually call it as Sit-Tat, meaning “Sit (Armed or Military), Tat (Forces).” Accordingly, the word “Sit-Tat” will be used interchangeably with military, army, junta’ troops, and armed Forces in this report instead of loaded term “Tatmadaw.”)
