- $49 \%$ of civilian deaths caused by armed conflicts occurred in Sagaing Region (February 1, 2021 - May 31, 2023)

At least $\mathbf{2 , 4 5 4}$ civilians have been killed in armed conflicts across the country since the coup. Sagaing Region saw $\mathbf{4 9} \%$ of these total deaths, with a numeral figure of no fewer than $\mathbf{1 , 2 0 8}$. Magway Region ranks second with at least 208 civilian deaths.

- Insignificant gap between civilian deaths in Myanmar's conflict and the war in Ukraine

When compared to international incidents, the total number of civilian casualties in Myanmar over the course of two years and four months since the coup is alarmingly high. For instance, as of May 20, 2023, the war in Ukraine resulting from Russia's invasion has claimed the lives of at least $\mathbf{8 , 8 9 5}$ civilians. This highlights the significant similarity between the number of civilian casualties caused by the destructive weapons utilized in Russia's invasion and the casualties resulting from violent clashes in Myanmar.
